What Are Articles?

Articles are words that define a noun as <u>specific</u> or <u>unspecific</u>

Types of Articles:

- Definite article (The)
- Indefinite article (A/ An)

1. The definite article:

The definite article is the word *the*. It limits the meaning of a noun to one particular thing.

Example:

- Please give me <u>the</u> hammer.
- Please give me the red hammer; the blue one is too small.

2. <u>The indefinite article:</u>

The indefinite article indicates that a noun refers as a general idea.

Forms of indefinite articles:

The indefinite article takes two forms.

- \circ When a word begins with a consonant, $\frac{1}{2}$ is used before the word.
- When a word begins with a vowel or vowel sound, <u>an</u> is used before word.

Examples

- Please pass me a book.
- Can I buy an umbrella?
- He is an honest man.

(An is used because the sound produced while pronouncing honest is of \underline{O} which is a vowel therefore an is used. Apparently, A should have been used because h is a consonant but the sound production prevents us from doing so)

a. Usage of articles:

Articles can be used with adjectives:

The word order is article + adjective + noun

Example:

- John will bring a small gift to Bob's party.
- I heard an interesting story yesterday.

b. Articles can be used with countable nouns:

Example:

- Please give me a bottle of water.
- Give me the bottle of water.

(There are many drinking items available but someone is only interested in water)

• Please give me an ice cube.

Give me the ice cube.

(Someone has asked someone to make him a large ice cube and he only interested in water.)

- We need a light in this room.
- Bring me the light in this room.
 (someone is just demanding light and nothing else)

c. <u>When articles are not:</u>

Article is omitted before nouns that refer to abstract ideas. /Articles are not used with abstract ideas or abstract nouns.

Examples:

- Let's go out for dinner tonight.
 [Let's go out for a dinner tonight. Incorrect]
- Creativity is a valuable quality in children
 [The creativity is a valuable quality in children. Incorrect]

Many languages and nationalities do not need an article.

Examples:

Pakistanis are very hospitable

[The Pakistanis are very hospitable. Incorrect]

Urdu is the official language of Pakistan.
 [The Urdu is the official language of Pakistan. Incorrect]

Sports and academic subjects do not require articles.

Examples:

- I like to play football.[I like to play the football. Incorrect]
- He is good at drawing.
 [He is good at the drawing. Incorrect]

Abstract nouns: advice, anger, beauty, confidence, courage, employment, fun, happiness, health, honesty, information, intelligence, knowledge, love, poverty, satisfaction, truth, wealth.

Substances: Sugar, Gold, Petrol, Crude oil.

One's relations: Father, brother, mother, sister, cook.

However, definite article can be used to specify relationships in some situations

EXAMPLE:

- The sister (the sister told all the secrets of her brother)
- The Father (The father is standing silently)
- The cook (The cook completed his eight weeks training last week)

IMPORTANT:

• Use the definite article **the** with any noun (whether singular or plural, count or noncount) when the specific identity of the noun is known.

Example: I ate an apple yesterday. The apple was juicy and delicious.

- To tell some thing is unique
 Example: The federal Budget of 2019.
 The provincial tax.
- Before proper nouns
 Example: The West Indies, The Arabian sea, The Atlantic Ocean, The Holy Quran.
